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
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Disability is the outcome of the physical and mental health conditions, which interact with the restrictive social/infrastructural/environmental factors. Disability can be of multiple kinds and of varying degrees, ranging from mild to severe. This makes access to services and provisions difficult, which includes housing, food security, employment, social protection, financial security, education, and health care.

Since Persons with Disabilities (PwDs or 'divyang' persons) continue to face inequality and exclusion in all aspects of their life, it is important to ensure that there are enough legislative, policy and schematic initiatives which address their needs. Therefore, appropriate budgetary allocation for PwD is an important step at the Union and State level. Pwd have a range of unique needs that are pertinent to be addressed by public policies.

To realise equal rights for persons with disabilities and progress towards their empowerment, laws, policies and schemes for their welfare must be backed by adequate budgetary commitments. 'Divyang Budgeting' presents an opportunity for the government to identify the nature and extent of its present resource allocations towards persons with disabilities, track and monitor their utilisation, and strengthen accountability towards the associated policy outcomes.

The Government of Assam brought out a Divyang Budget Statement in the financial year 2018-19 in which departments reported allocations wholly or partially targeted at persons with disabilities. This is an important and positive endeavour that can contribute to the empowerment and welfare of one of the most marginalised sections of society. Assam's Divyang Budget Statement witnessed many improvements over the years (refer to Table 1).

The Constitution of India guarantees PwD the fundamental rights to equality of opportunity and status, among others. Disability is also referenced multiple times in the Sustainable Development Goals Agenda - 2030, to which India is a signatory, especially with respect to growth, education and employment. With the enactment of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, India has a clear roadmap to ensure that persons with disabilities can exercise their rights and participate equally in the public sphere.






According to the Census 2011, PwDs constitute 1.8 per cent of Assam's total population. The Table 2 below shows the statistical profile of PwDs in Assam.


Status of the PwD population in Assam

Methodology Followed for Divyang Budgeting in Assam

The departments reporting under the Divyang Budget Statement are those which are directly or indirectly involved in financing or implementing Schemes/Programmes/Initiatives which benefit persons with disabilities. This also includes components which are specific for PwD and are being implemented by various departments. PwD could include, in this context, all persons with visual, hearing, speech & locomotive disability, mental retardation, mental illness, multiple disability and any other disabilities.

The Part A of the Divyang Budget Statement reports entire budget outlays for Schemes/Programmes/Initiatives for PwD. These are interventions which are specifically meant for PwD. The Part B of the Divyang Budget Statement reports components of Schemes/Programmes/Initiatives which are specific to PwD.





Actual Expenditure and Utilisation


The Actual Expenditure is available for the one financial year i.e., 2020-2021. The overall expenditure for FY 2020-21 is Rs 82,400.5 lakh. The Department of Finance, Government of Assam has been regularly monitoring the utilisation of funds for all the schemes / programmes.²

Six departments reported allocations under the Divyang Budget Statement in FY 2022-23. These departments, their budgetary allocations and percentage share of the total Divyang Budget Statement have been enumerated in Figure 2. Of these, the Social Welfare Department (Directorate of Social Welfare) contributes the most at 97.8% of the total budget under the Divyang Budget Statement.



Some key schemes (both Part A and Part B) of the Social Welfare Department are listed below:

Part A Schemes


- Deen Dayal Divyangjan Punarsansthapan Achoni- To provide divyang beneficiaries one time grant of Rs.
 20,000/- each.
- Deen Dayal Divyangjan Pension-To provide pension to the divyang beneficiaries @ Rs. 1000/- per month.

Part B Schemes

- Implementation of National Nutrition Mission (POSHAN Abhiyaan)- To end all forms of malnutrition, stunting and wasting in children under 5 years of age, and address the nutritional needs of adolescent girls, pregnant and lactating women.
- Implementation of Integrated Child Development Service Scheme (ICDS)-State Share- To reduce malnutrition, reduce anaemia of the women and improve the health and nutrition status of the children, school readiness of children.
